



The GRM Fuel Surcharge Policy

As you know gas prices have risen to unprecedented levels. In an industry dependent on deliveries, vehicle operating costs have elevated to levels that GRM can no longer continue to absorb. Effective September 1, 2008 GRM will be implementing a fuel surcharge policy. GRM's fuel surcharge will only apply to vehicle operated service items and will appear as a surcharge line item on your invoice.

Sliding Scale Surcharge

The GRM fuel surcharge will fluctuate on a sliding scale in conjunction with the rising and falling of On-Highway Fuel Prices as documented by the United States Energy Information Administration. As prices are supplied on a regional basis, each GRM location surcharge will differ according to regions as noted below.

Region GRM Location

Central Atlantic: NY, NJ, PA, DC

Lower Atlantic: GA, FL

Midwest: IL, Houston

California: San Francisco, Los Angeles

GRM will use \$2.00 as its base rate and will adjust up or down according to the fuel reports as provided by the U.S. Retail Motor Gasoline and On-Highway Diesel Fuel as identified in the table below. GRM will use this table to determine the current price of fuel.

GRM has also created a table to calculate surcharges (see GRM Fuel Surcharge). GRM has created this table so its customers can reference and calculate surcharges at any point in time and compare to invoiced totals.

Please note each month's surcharge will be calculated as follows. For example, July's invoice (for services incurred in June) will be based on price points for June. Please view the most recent [On-Highway Diesel Fuel Prices](#) as dictated by the U.S. Energy Information Administration. (Please Note: You will be directed away from GRM's website. How to Calculate Surcharge

1. Select your region and month—For example: California and June.
2. Refer to the table below titled "Retail Gasoline and Diesel Prices," and view the current gas price of \$4.213
3. Go to the second table titled "GRM Fuel Surcharge," identify the price point closest to \$4.213 rounding down—in this case \$4.20.
4. Follow this row across and you can view the GRM per trip surcharge of \$4.46.
5. This is the surcharge that will appear on your invoice.
